- a) \$700 return residents airfare
- b) A penalty of \$200 for non-delivery of priority baggage paid to the passenger
- c) Timing of recovery flights to be within a day
- d) Resuming of a weekly direct flight to CI-Perth-CI to accommodate for growth in travel, mail and passenger numbers
- e) That the contractor must have the capacity to integrate the services with Immigration and Infrastructure to provide a consolidated approach to mail, medical, food, freight and baggage. Priority to be given to food, medical and mail.
