CHANGE OF LANDFILL HOURS

Due to the Federal Government's announcement

The Shire of Christmas Island will be taking precautions with the picking up of the Quarantine Waste at the Detention Centre.

To ensure least possible amount of risk to the community, the Tip Site will be closed for burial of Quarantine waste. The daily closure's between 8 30am and 10am for delivery of and burial of Quarantine waste.

Tip Site will also close on weekends for the Quarantine period. The Shire will create a specific separate burial site for Quarantine waste away from the general Tip Site area. This is to reduce chances of contamination. As with usual practice, chalk is buried into organic / putrescible waste sites to prevent rats and other vermin. Scavenger Permits for the public will not be given out during the Quarantine period.
