#### 5.2 Dr. Jeremy PRINCE Stock Assessment Update

Dr. PRINCE of Biospherics presented the Stock Assessment Update for Wahoo. Dr. PRINCE utilised the historical data of catch from Mark ROCHFORD over the last year.

The formula shows that Wahoo are reproducing at a sustainable level based on the sample of Wahoo captured. In summary the replacement rate is 0.2, and the data we have collected so far is 0.25 – 0.40 which is very healthy. The modelling will only improve the more data we collect from Mark ROCHFORD and Shahrin JAMIL over time.

Dr. Kendra TRAVAILLE and Dr. Jeremy PRINCE requested the FMC consider which species to prioritise for the continues Stock Assessment Program research with the now trained Fisheries Officer Shahrin JAMIL.
