## SHIRE OF CHRISTMAS ISLAND REVISED SETTLEMENT CINEMA MASTERPLAN 28 APRIL 2020 PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

The Council at its ordinary meeting held on 11 February 2020 endorsed in principle the Draft **Settlement Cinema Draft Masterplan Feb 2020** and approve the release of the Masterplan for public comments including direct contact with the students of the CIDHS on the question of pump track as against a reduced skate park, with the intention to make a final decision at the April 2020 Ordinary Council Meeting.

Follow the public comment period and taking into account the commends from the Students at the CIDHS, together with the possible extension of the overall Masterplan area Council at its ordinary meeting held 28 April 2020 endorsed in principle the **Revised Settlement Cinema Masterplan 28 April 2020.** 

The Draft April 2020 plan is broader in both area and activates than the Draft Feb 2020 plan will be included in the next edition of the Islander and is also available for inspection at the Shire of Christmas Island Administration Office located at the George Fam Centre, 2 Murray Road, Christmas Island during normal business office hours Monday – Friday 7.30am to 4.00pm.
