##### **3.1 COVID-19 Protocols for Christmas Island**

##### **RESOLUTION 1**

The CCC strongly recommends again that the CI Territory Controller, the Administrator and the EMC implement the conditions outlined in the CCC resolution of 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 immediately.

Should that decision not take place immediately, the CCC strongly recommends to the CI community to remain in their homes over the weekend as per the Prime Minister's directives this week on the mainland to stay home unless absolutely necessary to minimize any possible contact with exempt Essential Staff.

## **RESOLUTION 2**

Resolved to advise the Territory Controller that there is wide community support for the CCC resolution of April 1<sup>st</sup> including from health workers on island.

To receive the communication made to the CCC since the April 1<sup>st</sup> meeting to advise the Territory Controller that a request has been put forward to have the Australian Defence Force and Australian Border Force wear masks at all times during bus transfers between plane and ship and that hand sanitizers also be made available at the commencement and end of these bus transfers. The request also includes that the bus driver be the last to get on and first to get off the bus and that he/she should be afforded mask, hand sanitizer and other personal protective equipment as necessary.

There has been awareness amongst workers in front line positions interacting with persons exempt from quarantine and so front line workers have informed the CCC to inform the Territory Controller on their behalf.
