GUIDELINES FOR HOW MANY CATS CAN BE KEPT ON PREMISES

1 Introduction

The 'Keeping and Control of Cats Local Law 2004' requires that "a person shall not ... keep a cat on any premises except in accordance with a valid permit issued in relation to those premises." (Clause 3.3(1))

3 Categories of Premises

- A 1-2 cats
- B 3-4 cats
- C 'Cattery' five and more cats

4 Conditions

- 4.1 Category 'A' Premises (1 2 cats)
 - each cat kept shall be an identified cat
 - each cat kept shall be neutered
 - the premises shall be maintained in good order and in a clean and sanitary condition
 - adequate space shall be provided on the premises for the exercise of the cats
- 4.2 Category 'B' Premises (3 4 cats)
 - each cat kept shall be an identified cat
 - each cat kept shall be neutered
 - the premises shall be maintained in good order and in a clean and sanitary condition
 - no cat shall be able to enter a food preparation area
 - adequate space shall be provided on the premises for the exercise of the cats
 - all complaints about the cats must be reported to the Shire
 - premises will be inspected annually by the Shire
- 4.3 Category 'C' Premises (Catteries)
 - i) Council Planning Approval is required to operate a category C (cattery) premises
 - ii) the maximum number of cats to be kept is 10
 - iii) each cat kept shall be an identified cat
 - iv) each cat kept shall be neutered
 - v) the premises shall have a feed room, wash area and isolation cages
 - vi) washing basins and running hot and cold water shall be available
 - vii) each cat is to be confined within an enclosure on the premises at all times
 - viii) all complaints about the cats must be reported to the Shire

- ix) a Shire building licence is required for each enclosure
- x) each enclosure shall
 - a) be a minimum 1.5 square metres per each cat and be a minimum 2 meters high
 - b) contain a shelter of minimum size 0.5m per each cat
 - c) be structurally sound, have impervious flooring, be well lit and ventilated
 - d) have internal surfaces that are smooth, free from cracks, crevices and defects
 - e) have fixtures, fittings and appliances capable of being easily cleaned, resistant to corrosion and constructed to prevent the harborage of vermin
- xi) each enclosure shall
 - a) be more than 2 meters inside the premises boundary
 - b) be more than 10 meters from any dwelling, church, schoolroom, hall or premises in which food is handled
 - c) be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected at least once a week
- xii) premises will be inspected regularly by the Shire
- xiii) other requirements for catteries are specified in the CI Cat Local Law 2004
